

Program Status Tables

This appendix provides summary status tables that are arranged by installation, DoD Component, and state. A brief summary of each of the tables follows.

Table B-1 provides status and cost information for DoD installations and Formerly Used Defense Sites (FUDS) that meet the following criteria:

- Investigations or cleanup actions are ongoing
- Installation has more than two sites
- FY98 estimated cost-to-completion is greater than \$1 million.

Table B-2 provides cost data for DoD installations and FUDS that meet the following criteria:

- Investigations or cleanup actions are ongoing
- Installation has two sites or fewer, or FY98 estimated cost-to-completion is less than or equal to \$1 million.

Table B-3 lists total number of sites and costs incurred for DoD installations and FUDS that have achieved Response Complete status at all sites.

Table B-4 provides data, by location (state), for the installations that have incurred potentially responsible party (PRP) costs of more than \$100,000 through FY97.

Table B-5 provides a summary-level view of the data presented in Table B-1. Status and cost totals are shown for each state, territory, and district (the District of Columbia), with information for DoD installations (operational and BRAC) and information for FUDS displayed separately.

Table B-6 provides a roll-up of the Table B-5 data for DoD installations as a whole (operational and BRAC) and for FUDS as a whole.

Table B-7 presents another summary-level view of the Table B-1 data. In this case, totals for the entire DoD program (including operational and BRAC installations) are broken down by Component—Army, Navy, Air Force, Defense Logistics Agency (DLA), and Defense Special Weapons Agency (DSWA). Data for FUDS are presented separately.

Table B-8 presents the same type of summary-level data as does Table B-6 but addresses only operational installations.

Table B-9 breaks down the Table B-8 data by Component (Army, Navy, Air Force, DLA, and DSWA).

Table B-10 presents the same type of summary-level information as do Tables B-6 and B-8, but for BRAC installations only.

Table B-11 breaks down the Table B-10 data by Component (Army, Navy, Air Force, DLA, and DSWA).

Table B-12 presents data for BRAC installations by BRAC round (1988, 1991, 1993, 1995).

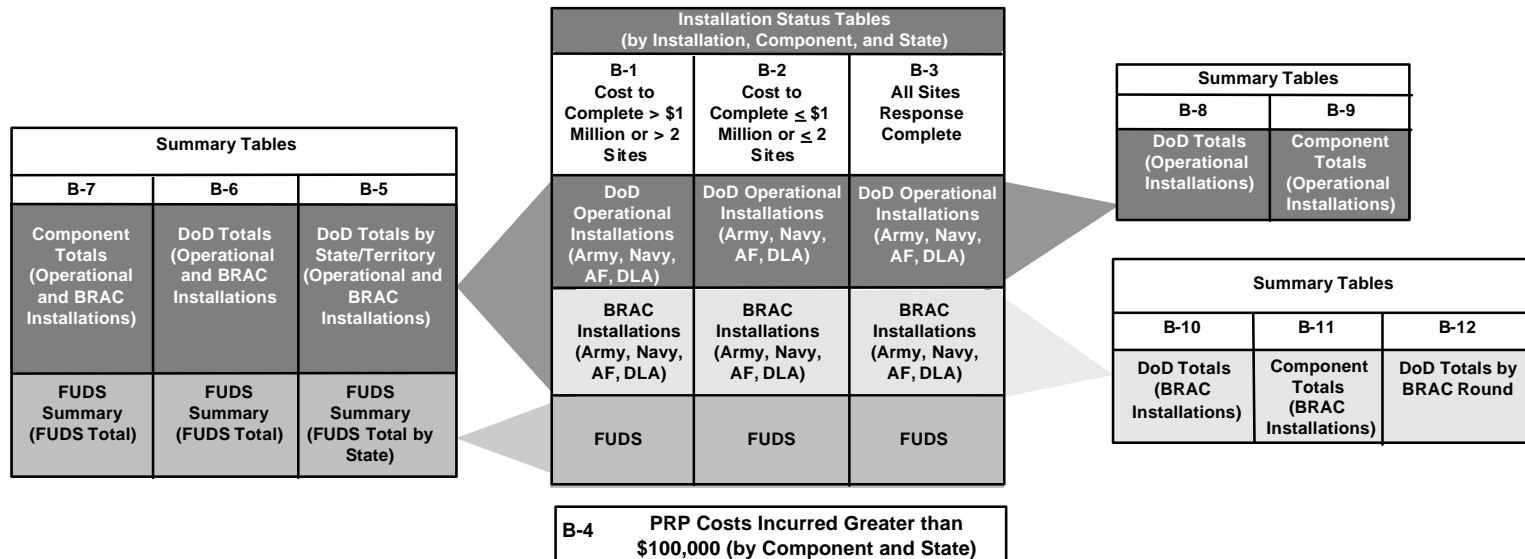


Below is a chart portraying the relationships among Tables B-1 through B-12.

Inconsistencies may exist between the information in these tables and the information in other parts of this report; such discrepancies can be attributed, for the most part, to the way in which project costs have been captured in the past. For example, at particular institutions, costs for Interim Actions and Designs often have been combined with the cost for actual cleanup, and costs for projects (such as

Preliminary Assessments) that covered multiple installations may not have been allocated to each installation involved. Also, these tables do not contain program support costs, only cleanup process costs.

Installation-level information is intended to be useful to members of Congress and their staff, interested members of the public, and other readers of this report. This information significantly enhances the visibility of the program at each installation.



The total number of installations and properties, including DoD operational and closing installations and FUDS, is 10,845. The number of installations reported for each DoD Component in Tables B-6 through B-12 is the number of installations *funded* by each Component. Note that the number of installations reported in these tables may exceed the number of actual installations because (1) installations may be funded by more than one DoD Component, (2) prior-year Defense Environmental Restoration Account (DERA) funding may be reported for installations that are now funded completely by the BRAC program, and (3) current and future DERA and BRAC funding may be reported for one installation at the same time. A list of the total number of installations reported by each DoD Component and by FUDS follows.
