OPEN PUBLIC MEETING

Shaw Air Force Base is currently conducting a series of detailed environmental activities under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act, a federal law enacted in 1980 to require the investigation and cleanup of contaminated sites throughout the country.

The base in conjunction with the city of Sumter, the county commissioners' office, the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the SC Department of Health and Environmental Control and the US Air Force Air Combat Command invites the public to attend and participate in a Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting to be held 18 September 95, 7:00 P.M. at the High Hills Middle School, Frierson Road, Shaw AFB, SC

The purpose of the meeting is to present a forum for open discussion of the activities being conducted to investigate environmental contamination. The status of base cleanup and remediation plans will be presented for public comment. The base geology and groundwater will be discussed in detail at this meeting. An interesting video will be presented to show the distinctive groundwater aquifer systems under the base. Those persons interested in the restoration activities at the base are encouraged to attend.
